This calendar provides key dates of religious holidays and celebrations, awareness raising days and other events which reflect our diverse local population.


It has been created as a resource for our staff to keep them informed of these key dates and encourage understanding and awareness of dates and events that may be important to our staff and patients.

Where you can see that a special day has been <u>underlined</u> in this calendar, this will then open a hyperlink should you wish to learn more about this event.


Ways that this calendar can be used:

- To engage in events, activities, celebrations and campaigns locally


